# **Important Notes & Reminders (TPCB):**

#### THE GROUP

The TPCB Student Retreat is held jointly with the Tri-I CBM program – total number of expected guests at the retreat is about 120 people.

#### BUS BOARDING – please be on time!

Our primary mode of transportation is by bus (we reserved 3 to take us to Woodloch). To help facilitate a smooth bus boarding experience, retreat participants are pre-assigned to a bus (either Bus #1, Bus #2 or Bus #3). Please see separate handout of bus assignments. Note that assignments were grouped by house number so roommates are riding the bus together. At the time of boarding, participants will receive a **luggage tag**. Please attach it to your bag so the resort can bring it directly to your room.

#### CHECK IN

Students staying in guest homes will not have access to their room (and luggage) until around 5 pm. We suggest you bring a backpack with you to carry personal items etc.

#### CHECK OUT

Please check out before breakfast on W, 9/27. Leave your luggage in the foyer of the house and the resort will bring it to the Clubhouse.

#### GETTING AROUND WOODLOCH RESORT – see map

Getting around the resort requires shuttle service. Note that guests cannot take the shuttle at their leisure and must adhere to the pick-up times on the schedule. All meals, meetings & activities will take place in the same building – **the Clubhouse**. All the houses are located on Pines Meadow Way (the 500's). The only activity that takes places on the main resort property is the Escape room – a shuttle will be provided for this activity.
